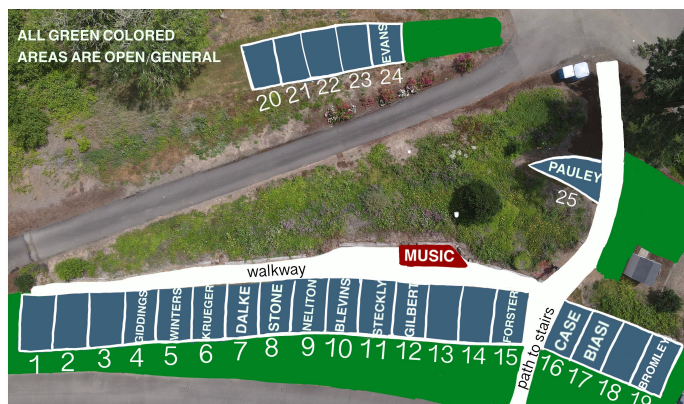

Due to the terms of our lease, **members are not allowed to bring fuel onto SYBC property** or refuel boats or jet skis anywhere on boat club grounds or the beach. This includes changing oil or working on engines.

We recognize that this may be an inconvenience but the hazardous materials clause in our lease makes the club responsible for any environmental cleanup resulting from accidental spills, which could cost tens of thousands of dollars. It simply isn't worth the risk. If you currently have fuel stored on the property, please remove it immediately.
